Note A-Box Express cars in series 10000 to 10099 are equipped with passenger fittings for express service and are not equipped with generators.

Baggage cars (A. A. R. Mech. Designation "BE") in series 2000 to 2034 and 2065 to 2110 are equipped with electric generators. Coaches in series 211 to 260, 301 to 325, 516, 524, 546 to 615, 645 and 646, Combined Baggage and Passenger series 409 to 424 and Mail and Passenger 425 are equipped as follows: Vestibules, electric generator, 2 flush toilets, wash basin in each toilet-Coaches Nos. 211 to 260.
