ROCKEFELLER CENTER MOTOR COACH

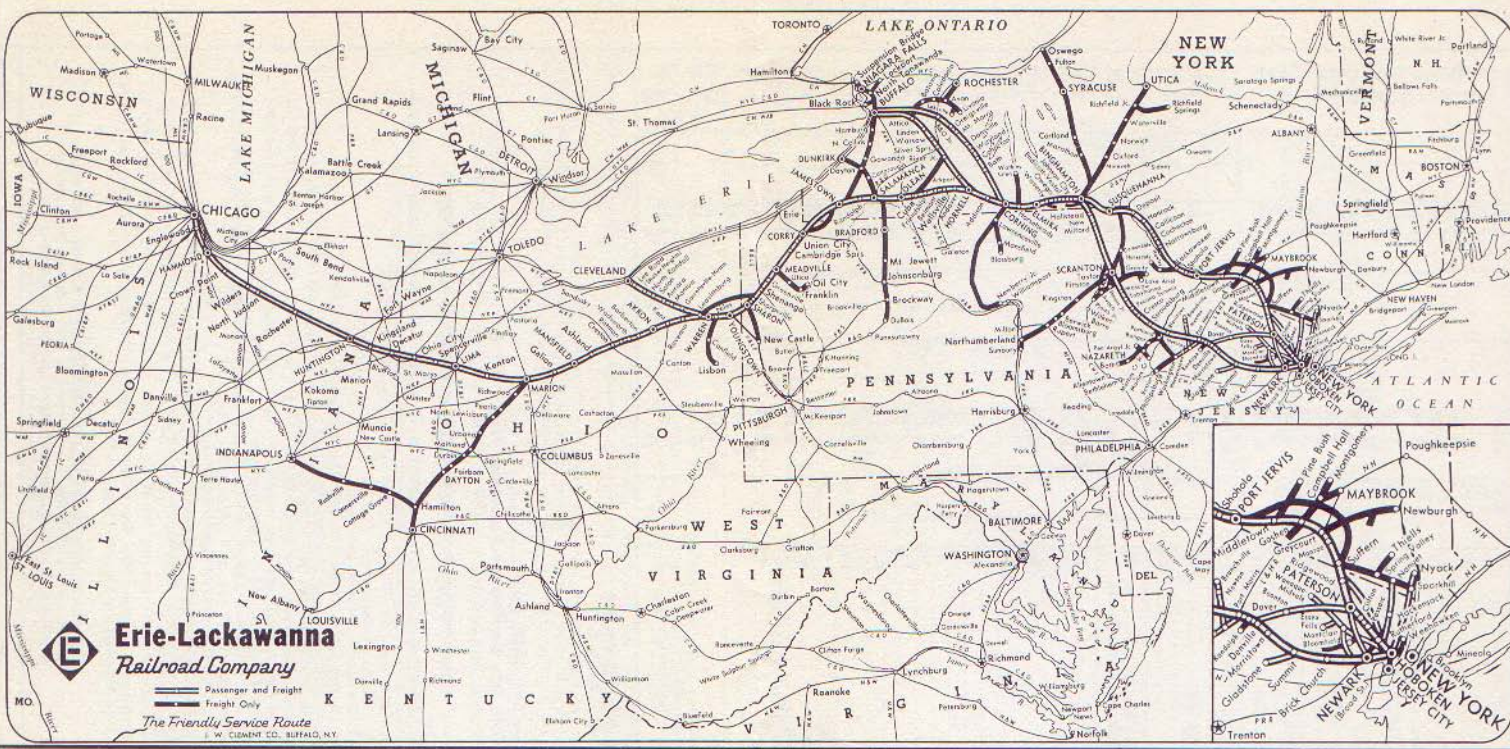
