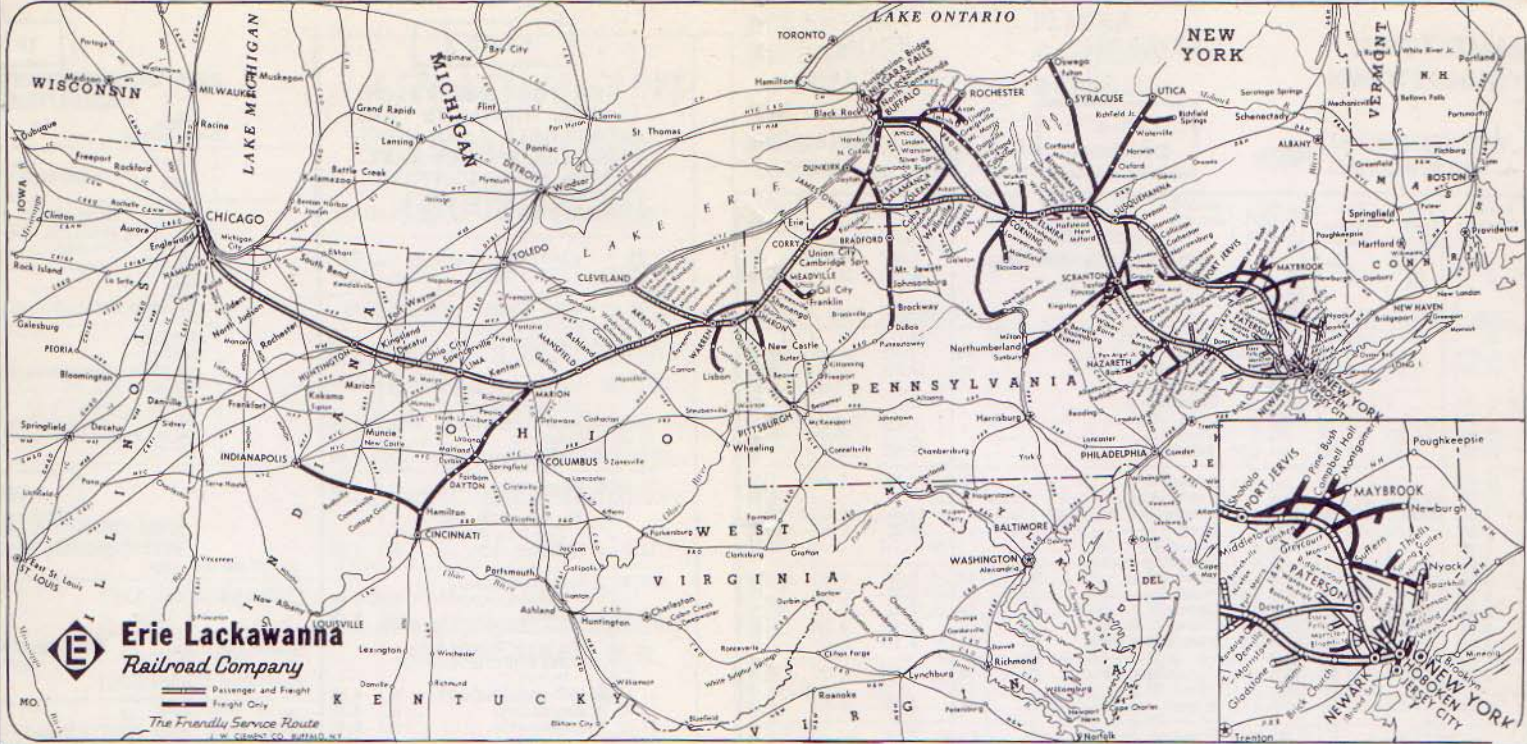

ROCKEFELLER CENTER MOTOR COACH

Direct service between the Hoboken Station and Rockefeller Center Terminal in midtown Manhattan, via the Holland Tunnel. Intermediate stops: inbound, along Eighth Avenue at W. 32nd Street and at W. 42nd Street; outbound, W. 34th Street and Eighth Avenue (Hotel New Yorker).

MOTOR COACH SERVICE — Between Rockefeller Center (11 Rockefeller Plaza), West 34th St. at 8th Ave., New York and Erie Lackawanna Terminal, Hoboken, direct to and from trainside, connecting with trains as indicated in table one. Fare, \$1.00.

PATH (Port Authority Trans-Hudson) — Tube trains between New York and Erie Lackawanna Terminal in Hoboken. From Downtown or Uptown, New York, take train marked "Hoboken"; to Downtown New York take train marked "Hudson Terminal" and to Uptown New York take train marked "33rd Street."
