
Individual Beds

By Ferry, passengers may go via Chambers Street Ferry to or from downtown; or West 23rd Street Ferry to or from uptown, via Jersey City Station. Ferry transportation is part of the rail transportation. No extra charge. The Hudson crossing is a skyline sightseeing sail that is priceless.

By Train-Cab you may go from Jersey City Station to any part of the Greater City. The service carries one person for 90c; two for \$1.25; three or more for \$1.50 from trainside, Jersey City, to Manhattan 110th St. and south or anywhere in the business district of Brooklyn. Beyond these zones regular charges apply.

By Hudson & Manhattan Tube Trains you can go to or from uptown or downtown New York via Jersey City Station. To or from uptown station (along Sixth Ave. to 33rd St.) the fare is 10c. To or from downtown (Church and Fulton Sts.) the fare is 8c. The service is frequent and fast.

By Rutherford Transfer Motor Coach between trainside at Rutherford, N. J., and Times Square Motor Coach Terminal, 260 West 42nd St., between 7th and 8th Aves., New York. There is a small charge for this time-saving service. Hand baggage is transferred

free. Get motor coach tickets from your Erie Agent or the Conductor. Going to New York there is a motor coach connection for trains No. 2, No. 6 and No. 8. Leaving New York there is a motor coach connection for trains No. 1, No. 27 and No. 5.

Erie passengers now have this service available in key cities along the line: CHICAGO, ILL., AKRON, CLEVELAND and YOUNGSTOWN, OHIO, and BUFFALO, N. Y.

In each of the cities mentioned, with the exception of Chicago the taxicab company will furnish a cab and driver from 9:00 A.M. to 3:00 P.M. for \$5.00. In Chicago a special rate will be any continuous four hours for \$5.00. Ask ticket agents.

You may taxi from the railroad depot or your hotel to the Drivurself Company office, or garage, and your fare will be paid up to 35c, this amount being deducted from your bill.
