

Erie Train-Cab Service at New York has steadily increased in popularity. Thousands have used and praised it.

Briefly, Train-Cab Service is the carrying of passengers from their door in New York or Brooklyn to our trains (and vice versa).

Strangers arriving at Erie Terminal, Jersey City, are taken directly to their destination. They never get "lost" and are never overcharged. The same is true of westbound passengers. Women accompanied by children appreciate the service. Even seasoned travellers enjoy the comfort of settling down in their own taxicab and forgetting about bags and car changes.

The fares shown above apply between our terminal and any place on Manhattan, 110th Street and south, also between the terminal and any point in the Brooklyn business district.

Service beyond the prescribed zones is metered to or from the zone limits and charged for at regular rates.

Train-Cab Service is available to all who travel between Greater New York and Erie points, Middletown and west.

If you are travelling to New York you can buy the Train-Cab coupon with your rail ticket at the ticket office or from the conductor on any through train and you will find your taxicab awaiting the arrival of your train at Jersey City.

Travelling from New York you can buy the Train-Cab coupon with your rail ticket. The ticket agent will gladly arrange to have a taxicab sent for you at your home, hotel or office, or, if preferred, you yourself may phone for a Parmelee System Taxicab or hail one on the street.

It is not necessary, however, to buy your Train-Cab coupon before you call your taxicab. You may, if you choose, purchase it at Jersey City Terminal with your rail ticket on arrival there.


