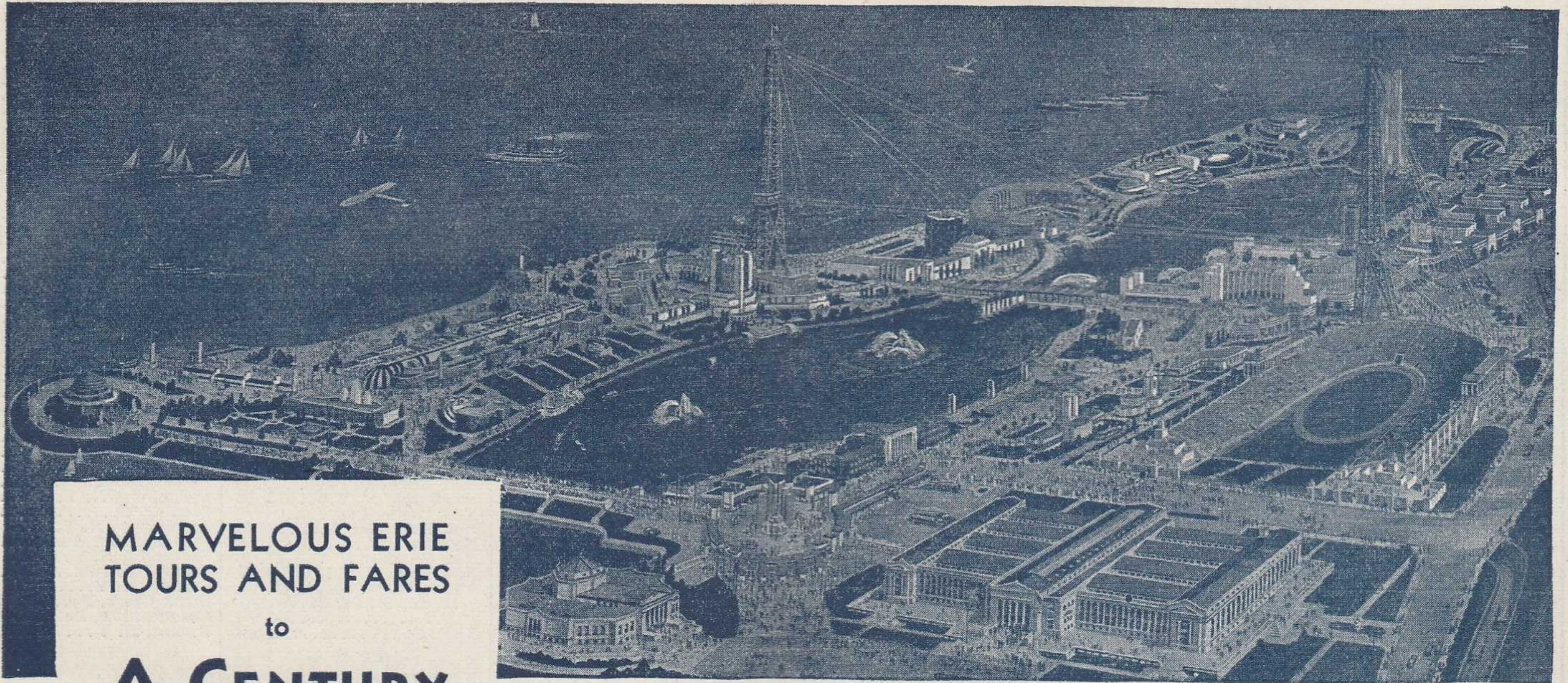

General View of the Exposition

Examples of our low Individual Round Trip Fares are: Ten day ticket on sale Tuesdays and Saturdays to Oct. 28, inclusive. Good in coaches and Pullmans \$31.00 from New York. This is the equivalent of one way fare plus 25c for the round trip.

Nine day ticket on sale daily to Oct. 29, inclusive. Good in coaches \$25.60 from New York. This is equal to $\frac{5}{8}$ of the regular one way fare for the round trip. Proportionately lower fares apply from other stations. There are also attractive individual fares with longer limits.

For groups there are Round Trip Party Fares covering 25 or more; also 100 or more people with a nine day return limit at fares even lower than those quoted above.

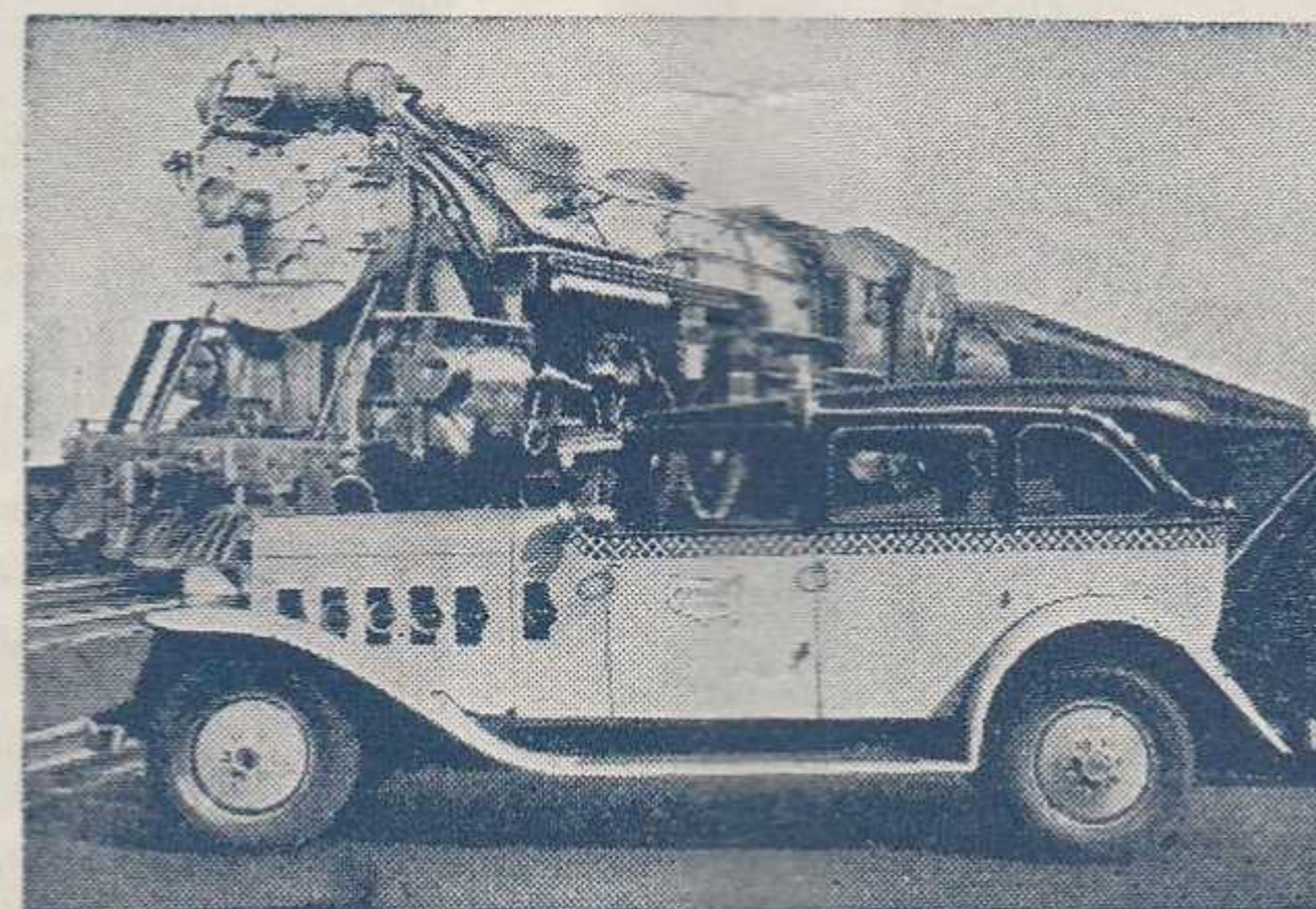
