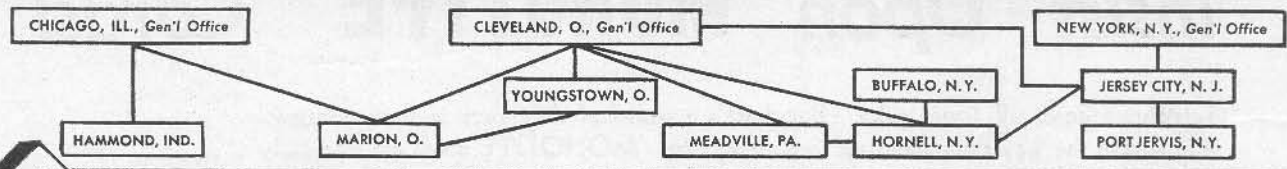


# NEW TELETYPE system speeds freight for ERIE



**2483 miles of  
printer circuits link  
general offices and yards**

Erie's new Teletype system for handling train consists went into service on March 1st. It provides instantaneous typewritten communication between points on the diagram above.

Teletyped car-by-car train lists are now delivered to general offices within a few minutes after departure of trains

from reporting yards. There, centralized tracing bureaus use the information to answer quickly all inquiries from shippers and receivers. From Cleveland, car movement reports are mailed daily (many by airmail) to Erie representatives in 65 cities throughout this country and Canada.

Teletype also expedites the planning of break-up and train operation and the preparation of switching lists. It aids in prompt and accurate execution of diversion or reconsignment instructions.

2308 miles of Erie's printer circuits

are equipped with duplex apparatus so that Teletype messages can be sent in both directions simultaneously.
